GBG and POTY Voting

This year the preferred method of registering your votes is via an online form on our website **www.peterborough.camra.org.uk**. Once on the site you will have to log into the member's area with your CAMRA membership number and password. The link to voting is then on top of the next page. This voting form requires you to fill out a number of essential fields that include entering at least one entry to both to Pub of the Year and Good Beer Guide, your name, membership number and email address. The email address is important as this will allow us to digitally send out CAMRA information directly to you including news of events, volunteering requests and this voting information for next year.

If you do not have an email or do not wish to receive these emails you can still vote by posting your entries on the voting slip on the reverse of this letter.
